DELTA FAIR 4-H/FFA JUNIOR OPEN LIVESTOCK SALE GUIDELINES

- 1. The 4-H/FFA Sale is sponsored by (to be announced).
- 2. Sale is open to 4-H/FFA exhibitors.
- 3. All animals will sell by head in dollars per pound.
- 4. If selected by the buyer, animal must sell.
- 5. All sales are between the buyer and the seller.
- 6. Sell order will be based on placing in show.
- 7. The Delta Fair Board and Sale Committee will collect the payment from the buyer and distribute checks as soon as all money is collected.
- 8. All entries subject to approval of the Delta Fair Board.
- 9. Proper health and test papers of all market animals are required to be on file with the Delta Fair Board.
- 10. Livestock will sell by local market guidelines.
- 11. Exhibitors must be present at Livestock Auction for livestock to show and sell.
- 12. A market animal can be shown and sold at another fair and still be qualified to be shown and sold at the Delta Fair, PROVIDING that it was not a terminal sale and meets ownership requirements.
- 13. Animals must meet weight requirements, or they will not show or sell.
- 14. An exhibitor does not have to participate in the sale if they choose to take their animal home with them, UNLESS they have the Grand Champion or Reserve Grand Champion. If the animal is sold to a buyer, the buyer has to option to take the animal with them (even if the exhibitor has chosen to take the animal home with them), and the exhibitor will be paid the total sale price. If the buyer chooses to pay only the premium (the difference between the market price and the final sale price) on the animal, and the exhibitor has chosen to take the animal home, then they exhibitor will be paid the premium amount only (the sale amount less the market value).
- 15. ALL NOMINATION AND REGISTRATIONS MUST BE TURNED IN BY THE DESIGNATED DEADLINES. NO EXCEPTIONS!
